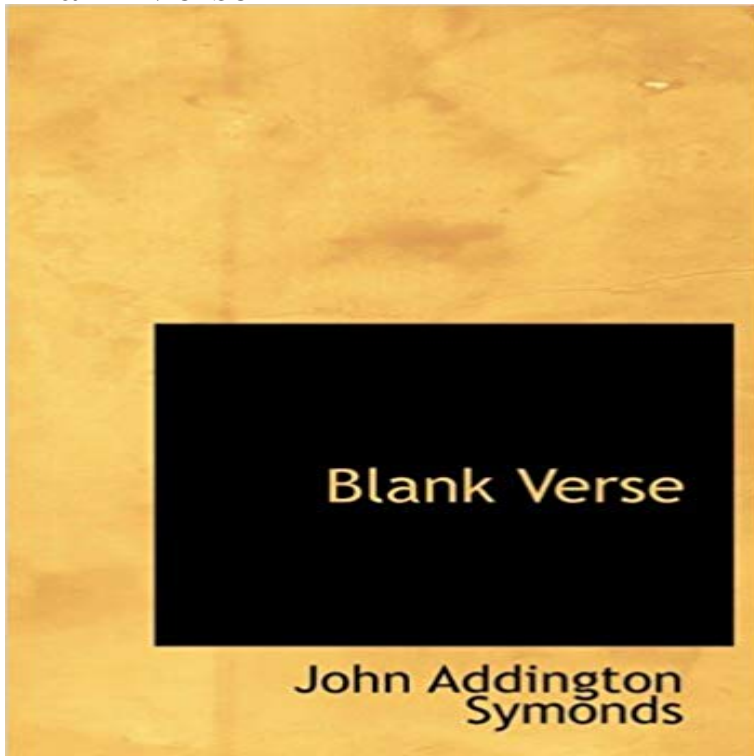


Blank Verse
