
Dickenss Style (Cambridge Studies in Nineteenth-Century Literature and Culture)

They show that style is not simply an aesthetic quality isolated from the deepest meanings of Dickenss fiction, but that it is inextricably involved with all kinds of historical, political and ideological concerns. Written in a lively and accessible manner by leading Dickens scholars, the collection ranges across all Dickenss writing, including the novels, journalism and letters.
