
## Daniel Defoe (Cambridge Library Collection - English Men of Letters)



Published in the first series of English Men of Letters in 1879, a time when a complete edition of Daniel Defoes works was yet to be collated, this biographical account by William Minto (1845-93) was a significant achievement in literary scholarship as well as an engaging portrait of a colourful and outspoken polemicist. Himself a journalist and essayist for the pioneering Pall Mall Gazette and the Daily News, Minto combines the critical insight of a literary scholar with the empathy understanding of a fellow writer. Spanning the novelists entire life (c. 1659-1731), from the passions of his youth to the publication of Robinson Crusoe, his later journalistic labours and the impact of literary success, this biography tells how Defoe disproved the rule that the lives of men of letters are rarely eventful.
