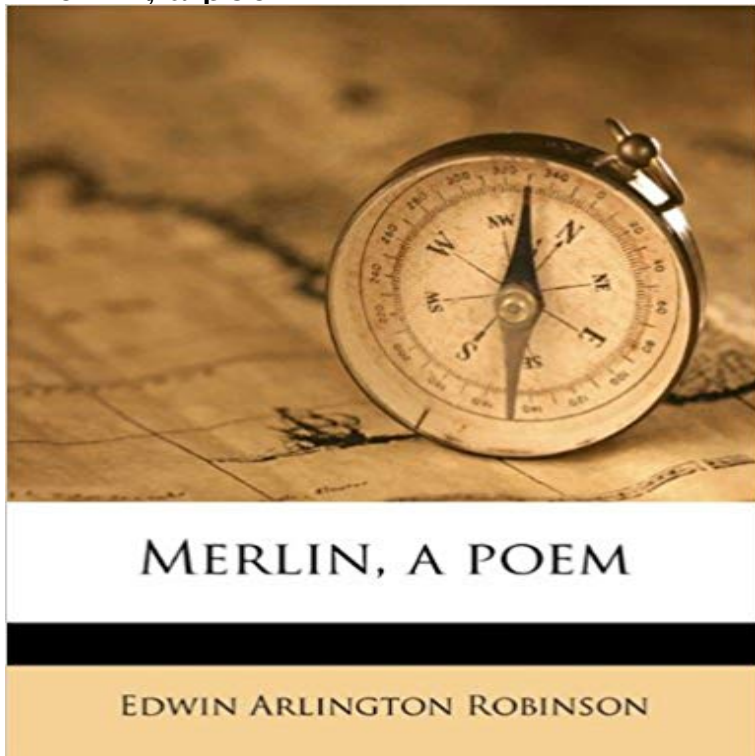


Merlin, a poem
