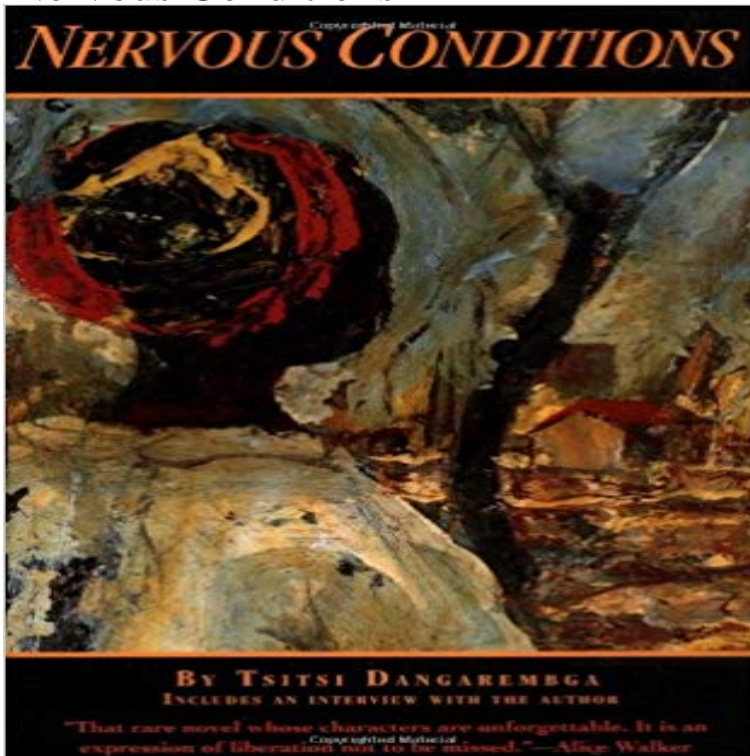


Nervous Conditions
