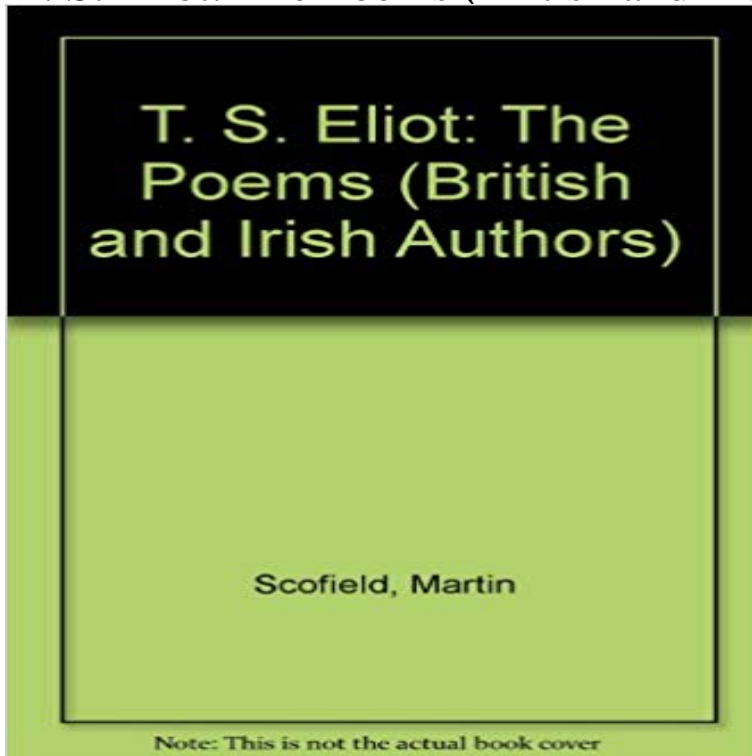


T. S. Eliot: The Poems (British and Irish Authors)
